Prayer for the Sick: Accept the prayers we offer for our brothers and sisters who are ill, that, having been anxious for them in their danger, we may rejoice at their recovery of health. *cf. Roman Missal*

Wednesday this week, 14th February, is Ash Wednesday. It is also a Day of Fasting and Abstinence. Mass, with the Imposition of Ashes, is at St. Cecilia's, 10:15am.

Stations of the Cross on Fridays in Lent: 16th February, 12 noon at St Edmund's Parish Church, Hunstanton.
Followed [it is expected] by a Hunger Lunch.

Coach Trip to Walsingham, Wednesday, 21st February, with the opportunity to attend **Mass in the Basilica** and enjoy the **Snowdrop Walk in the Abbey Grounds**. The cost for the coach is **£5.00 per person**, collected on the day. There is a **charge of £5.00 for entry into the Abbey Grounds**, if you wish to visit. Individual lunch arrangements can be made at any one of a variety of venues in the village. We need a minimum of 20 people to make the trip viable. Please sign the sheet in the Porch this weekend if you are interested. If the trip goes ahead, there will be no Mass at St. Cecilia's that day.
Given the date, why not consider this as a Lenten Pilgrimage.

CAFOD Family Fast Day is Friday, 23rd February. The Government has promised to double donations up to a total of £5 million, so this is a wonderful opportunity to make a real and lasting difference to more of our brothers and sisters in more deprived parts of the world.

Deanery Station Masses, celebrated by Bishop Alan: The Station Mass for our Deanery will be at **Holy Family on Tuesday, 6th March. Exposition from 6:00pm** [Confessions available]; **Mass – 7.00pm**, followed by refreshments. Lenten Alms: There will be a Collection Box throughout Lent in the Porch of each Church for the Diocesan appointed charities – this year: 'Aid to the Church in Need (Syria & Iraq)' and 'Don't Screen Us Out'.

Another Idea for 'Lenten Alms': Find a box or basket at home; during Lent put in it one item each day – groceries, toiletries, new clothing (eg hat, scarf, gloves) then bring the accumulated contents to Church and put them in the Food Bank Box. The items can be brought in weekly, fortnightly or periodically during Lent.
